




Introduction

The Comprehensive LSA/TA course is one of our flagship courses in the UAE. Module 1: Introduction

This module is an introduction to the roles, responsibilities and boundaries of a Teaching Assistant/Learning Support Assistants especially in the context of UAE. It delves into the importance of collaboration with teachers and how to effectively work with teachers and other stakeholders. It looks at the key theories of child development and the importance of recognising diverse learning styles in children. It opens the mind of the learners into the challenging, exciting and rewarding world of Inclusive education





Module 2: Safeguarding, Child Protection & Positive Handling

This module is about the safety and well-being of the children. It emphasises the significance of safeguarding and child protection in educational settings. It also covers identifying signs of physical and emotional abuse, neglect and how to effectively respond to safeguarding concerns. The module also covers school policies and procedures regarding safeguarding, and conclude the positive handling techniques.





Module 3: Understanding Barriers and how to support

This module looks at the UAE Inclusive Education Framework and international best practices and addresses the different types of obstacles and barriers to learning and various strategies that can be used to support children with special needs such as ADHD, Autism, ODD, OCD, Dyslexia, and GDD. We will explore in depth how to provide support to children with these difficulties and create an inclusive environment for these children!





Module 4: Teaching and Learning Support.

This module explores effective teaching techniques and understanding the teaching and learning process. It explores the importance of multi-sensory teaching approaches. Additionally, the modules covers the elements of teaching and learning and how an understanding of each of the elements impacts the children's ability to make progress in their academics. Finally the modules looks at differentiated instruction, adapting learning to suit various needs, offering constructive feedback, and use of assistive technology.







Module 5: Assessments and Support

This module explores the different types of Assessments, and how to support children during these assessments. It looks at different access arrangement and how to effectively support children that qualifies for these access arrangements. Additionally, the modules explains what modified assessments are and how Teaching Assistants can contribute to modified assessments.





Module 6: IEPs and OPPs (Individualised Planning)

This module focuses on creating personalised plans, delivering tailored instructions, adjusting and modifying instructions to cater to all students' needs. You will also learn about writing Individual Education Plans and One Page Profiles for students with special needs. Included also is information about how to monitor progress towards goals, while conducting regular reviews of the targets set in IEPs







Module 7: Behaviour Support using ABA

This module looks at Behaviour support and classroom management. It introduces the learners to Applied Behaviour Analysis and how it can be used to support in the classroom. It provides an overview of ABA principles, antecedents and consequences, The ABC of behaviour, implementation of behaviour intervention, cultural considerations in ABA. It also looks at ABA support in autism.





Module 8: Reflections

This module covers preparation for employment as a TA/LSA in the UAE. It covers reflections around covered topics, practical experiences and it gives the learners the opportunities to address challenges, and the opportunities for students to ask questions about all the topics covered and those that are not part of the course but part of inclusion and special needs support







Coaching/Mentoring Session

This optional session is a preparation session, where we prepare students for interviews and support them in writing CVs that stands them out from the crowd. While this session is optional, we strongly advise students to attend and brush themselves up to be better prepared to face the inclusion world.





Assessment:

Throughout the course, there will be informal formative assessments. An essay type assessment will be given to students. This assessment will cover most parts of the course. To successfully pass the course, students are required to be present and participate in 90% of the online lessons and pass the essay type assessment. There will be opportunity to retake the lessons for free if students do not meet the standard expected







Online Lessons

All sessions one are conducted online. The students are required to have their cameras turned on while attending. This is mandatory. It's important for the students to ensure that they are in an environment that fosters focus and encourages active participation throughout the sessions.
